

## Vaccines available at our clinic

1. Vaccines can only be free if you have a valid B.C. Services Card
2. We do not provide routine childhood vaccinations
3. For Injections of vaccines not covered by your B.C. Services Card, cost may vary.

<b>Chickenpox</b> (varicella)	Free
<b>Hepatitis A</b>	Purchase at the pharmacy (free with some medical conditions)
<b>Hepatitis B</b>	Purchase at the pharmacy (free with some medical conditions)
Combined Hepatitis A & B ( <b>Twinrix</b> )	We provide the prescription, you purchase and obtain injection at pharmacy
<b>HPV</b> (human papillomavirus, cervical cancer, <b>Cervarix</b> , <b>Gardasil</b> )	We provide the prescription, you purchase and obtain injection at the pharmacy
<b>Influenza</b> injection ( <b>flu</b> )	Available October until January for \$50 (free in some cases)
<b>Influenza</b> nasal spray ( <b>FluMist</b> )	Usually available October until January for \$50 (free in some cases)
Measles, Mumps, Rubella ( <b>MMR</b> )	Free
<b>Meningococcus</b> (meningitis)	Free
<b>Pneumococcus</b> (pneumonia, <b>Pneumovax</b> )	Free
<b>Polio</b>	Free
<b>Shingles</b> (Zostavax, Shingrix)	We provide the prescription, you purchase and obtain at the pharmacy
<b>TB Test</b> (tuberculosis skin test)	Two visits 48 hrs to 72 hrs apart, each cost \$75
<b>Tetanus</b> (Td)	Free
Whooping cough ( <b>pertussis</b> )	Free
